ABOUT THE SPEAKERS:

Sandra Lee Boody, DA, RDH, MVE

Sandy has spent her entire career initiating and implementing health care technical training. After graduating from the University of Pittsburgh's Dental Assisting / Dental Hygiene program and the School of Vocational Education, she spent 25 years as the Director of the Dental Careers Program at Northern Area Special Purpose Schools. She developed and published competency-based curriculum for the Department of Education and also presented curriculum seminars and bi-annual Technical Updates for Dental Educators at State and National Health Curriculum conferences.

Since the beginning of her dental hygiene career, Ms. Boody has also worked clinically in the hospital and nursing home arena. Sandy has also been employed as a private practice clinical hygienist, a product representative and sales team educator. Most recently, she has served as an oral care consultant, training nursing staff in critical care settings, rehabilitation, nursing homes and hospice care. She also completed Orofacial Myology training at the University of Southern California.

Having survived the ravages of Head and Neck cancer, she now speaks to dental/medical audiences, and support groups. Her personal journey, in combination with her years of clinical experience, has been an inspiration to national and international audiences.

Patricia is a licensed dental hygienist, a certified clinical research professional, and a Research Fellow in the Oral Health Clinical Research Center at the University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. Ms Lenton earned both her undergraduate degree in Dental Hygiene Education and her graduate degree in Training and Development from the University of Minnesota. In 1989 Pat was invited to interview for a position as a clinical examiner in the Oral Health Clinical Research Center at the School of Dentistry. She accepted a temporary, one-year position on a clinical trial at that time and has continued her employment in clinical research ever since. During her career at the School of Dentistry, Pat has served as a clinical examiner, a study coordinator, and as Principal Investigator on numerous clinical trials funded by both NIH and by corporate sponsors. She has written numerous continuing education programs for the School of Dentistry including courses related to the relationship between oral health and diabetes.

Ms. Lenton is a member of the International Society of Breath Odor Research (ISBOR), the International Association of Dental Research (IADR), The Society of Clinical Research Professionals (SoCRA), and the American Dental Hygiene Association (ADHA). Locally, Pat is an active member of the Minnesota Dental Hygienists' Association and a member of the St. Paul District Dental Society Mid-winter Meeting planning committee. She has served as President of the Oral Health Research Group in the IADR and Secretary General of the ISBOR.
