From 1991-1995, he was Chief, Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, at Wm. Beaumont Army Medical Center, Fort Bliss, Texas. He served at the National Naval Dental Center, Bethesda, Maryland as a Professor of the Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology training program from 1996-2000 and as Assistant Program Director from 1998-2000. From 2000-2002, he acted as Chief Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at Eisenhower Army Medical Center, Ft. Gordon, Georgia.

His current professional memberships include Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, Fellow of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, Member of the American Dental Association, Member of the American Dental Educators Association, and Council member, American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology.
